What information do you need to make the right decision for you about progressing onto higher education?

How can I compare degree courses to find out which one is right for me?

- > Degree courses with the same name may have very different approaches. Unit information for each degree course is available on university websites and will allow you to get a really good idea about the course content and assessment methods used.
- > Most universities offer opportunities to visit such open days. The university contacts overleaf will be able to advise you of these.

What are admission tutors looking for in applications from Access to HE Diploma students?

- > University websites should give details of the Access Diploma credits needed for different courses and any additional requirements.
- > Don't hesitate to ring the university contacts given overleaf to check admissions policies towards Access students.

What selection process will different courses use?

- > The key elements in the selection process will be the personal statement, the reference and possibly the interview.

What financial support am I entitled to?

- > A good source of information is the Student Finance England website at www.studentfinanceengland.co.uk.
